Free School Meals Vouchers

Free school meal vouchers for the Christmas holiday period for pupils eligible for means tested free school meals will be issued. Please ensure the school has your up-to-date email details and if you feel your circumstances may have changed and you may now be eligible please let the office know or use the following link https://www.gov.uk/apply-free-school-meals/norfolk

This Christmas will see an increase to £55 for the period. This is based on the usual £15 per child per week plus an additional £25 per child to help families free up household finances in advance of an anticipated rise in energy costs in January and to try and help children enjoy a better Christmas than they might otherwise have.
