We hope you all had a lovely Easter break. We are looking forward to seeing you all back in school and we hope you are all ready for another exciting half term in North America class.

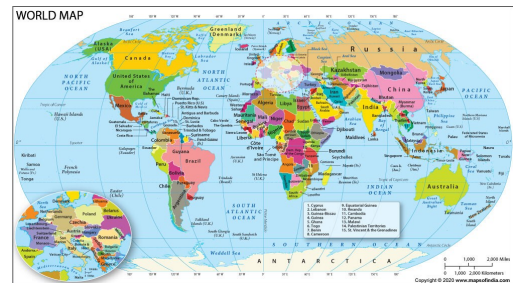

Any queries please contact the school office and we will get back to you.

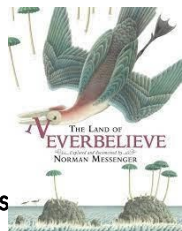
This half term's learning:

This half term's topic is all about
Mapping the World
This means our topic focus this half term will be **Geography**



English learning objectives:

This half term we will be linking our writing to our topic of mapping the world. We will be using a book called *The Land of Neverbelieve*. We will be writing information texts and poems about nature.



Maths objectives:

This half term's focus we will be on recapping our learning so far and improving the children's confidence in areas they find challenging. After the SATs we will look more at Maths projects and challenges.

Other curriculum areas :

In **Science** we will learn about electricity and circuits.

In **Geography** we will learn about mapping the world. We will look at what maps can tell us, how to locate places on a map and how to read an OS map.

Our **Art** this half term will link to our topic and our work on animals of the world. We will be doing some sketches of animals
