This half term's learning:
This half term we are going to be learning all about
Planet Earth

The children will be exploring Planet Earth
in Geography.

They will also be applying this knowledge in
their Science when learning about
different habitats.



English

We will begin this half term by exploring poetry and reciting 'The Owl and the Pussy Cat'. We will then innovate and perform our own version of the poem.

We will then look at 'The Owl Who Was Afraid of the Dark'.
We will create a new narrative for the story.

In addition:

Children will also be able to:

- Use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops
- Use past tense
- Use coordination
- Use subordination
- Use different sentence types



In **phonics**, children will continue to focus and recap sounds using RWI (Read Write, inc). Children will apply their phonics knowledge to their reading and spelling.

In **spelling**, we will be learning new spelling rules.

The children will receive weekly Spellings and will be tested on these every Friday.

Maths

Every day the children will practice their number fluency through Number Ninjas followed by a short weekly arithmetic quiz on a Friday.

Our learning focus will be on:

- Money
- Multiplication and division
- Answering problem solving and reasoning questions

Science

We be will learning about Habitats. We will explore how we know something is alive and where living things live.

RE

In RE we will investigate the question 'How do Christians belong to their faith family?'

Art

We will be exploring the work of Henri Rousseau, practicing and applying his skills to create our own artwork of animals in their habitats.

Computing

We will be learning about presenting data and information. Children will be creating pictograms.



Music

Music lessons will be provided by the Norfolk Music Hub and linked closely to our topic.

We will be exploring what jobs people do. We will discuss what jobs we want to do and why.

We will be practicing dance with Mrs Greenland.
